1. **Ethics:**

Summarize how you apply the 4-way test in your life, your approach to decisions, your priorities and your values.

2. **Service Above Self:**

Summarize your service to others, above and beyond that which is required in class.

3. **Vocation Preparation:**

Summarize how you have prepared to succeed.

- Leadership Activities
- Scholarship (course selection, ACT score, grade point)

4. **Communication Skills:**

How you look, speak and write are a reflection of your values and standards. Your written application and interview will be used to evaluate these skills.

Is your application complete? Incomplete applications will not be considered for scholarship eligibility.

- Application form (with name, etc.) signed by you and your counselor
- 1 Recommendation form from any person you choose
- 1 Recommendation form from the Interact Sponsor
- A letter of recommendation from either of the references used
- Your essay as listed above
- A copy of your transcript
- Resume
