Motion to approve the bills:

I move to approve the transfer from the General Fund on an "as need basis" to cover expenses attributed to the Transportation, Vocational Education, Food Service, and Bilingual Special Funds, and to pay bills in the amount of **\$861,940.87**.

Option(s) to move to go into Executive Session for purpose(s) of discussing:

1. Personnel matters of non-elected personnel to protect the privacy interests of the individual(s) to be discussed.
