

Mr. Rietcheck's Scholarship & Requirements

Scholarship Description:

The Rietcheck Scholarship is one that has been granted by Mr. Rietcheck, a teacher at Ulysses High School and Mr. Rietcheck's family members. This scholarship is made to find an outstanding student, which has emphasized his/her academic success. Applicants must be in good academic standing and have shown a promising future at the collegiate level. This scholarship will be to the amount of \$1,000, which has been sponsored by Mr. Rietcheck, 4RCattle Co., Hombre Inc., and D.J. and Megan Farming Inc.

Requirements of the Scholarship

To be eligible for consideration for this scholarship, students must meet the following requirements:

- Must be a graduating student of the current school year, from Ulysses High School.
- Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.3.
- Must be active within the school (be part of clubs, organizations, sports, etc.)
- Must partake in an interview which will be held for each of the applicants that are qualified and have met the above requirements.
- Must provide all the documents listed below

Documents that must be provided

1. Application, which will provide the basic information.
 - a. The application can be found under the counselor page at www.usd214.org.
2. Transcripts, showing they have an accumulative GPA of 3.3 or higher (these can be either official or unofficial).
3. Resume, showing the activities in which the student has been active, jobs, clubs and organizations outside of school etc.
4. Essay, Each student who applies will submit an essay. The requirements for this essay and the question will be set as follows:
 - a. Must be 2 pages long, single spaced
 - b. Font- Times New Roman
 - c. Font Size- 12 point font
 - d. Margins- All papers must have 1 inch margins
 - e. Must answer the following question- Discuss the importance of education and your future plans for your education?
5. Letter of Recommendation, from a school official (teacher, principal, club sponsor, etc.)
6. Folder, all the materials will be presented to Mr. Rietcheck in a manila folder which can be found in Mr. Rietcheck's office at Ulysses High School
